Description:

- Vocational training school under the Ministry of Education and Sports since 1964
- Supported by the Federal Republic of Germany since 1993
- Currently around 1,300 students, offers different vocational training courses
- English is already an integral part of the training courses, but at a low level

Duration of the internship: 3-6 months, starting mid-September

Tasks: In-service teacher training for Lao English teachers in didactics, methodology and English language, development of teaching material, teaching students of chosen classes, organizing workshops

Requirements: Language training especially for adults, patience and intercultural competences, creativity and team-work, e.g. for the further development of material

Challenges: Socialist Least Developed Country, English as a school subject only started 15 years ago, very low level of English throughout the country, lacks in school management

Accommodation: Bungalow right next to the school, western standard

Funding: Flights, accommodation and food are covered by Angels for Children and the engineering company BHS Corrugated, which runs own vocational training courses at the school
